Proposed specific aims: 1. To assess whether survivors have a higher trend towards unemployment than siblings from 2003 to 2007. We will examine the proportion of survivors and siblings in different employment categories (employed; not working due to health or disability; unemployed and looking for work; not in the labor force) in 2003 and 2007 and test for interaction effects by survivor/sibling status and year. Because of differences in employment status by age, we will examine the proportions within specific age cohorts (e.g., 25-29; 30-34; 35-40; 40+ at 2003). Sex-stratified analyses may also be warranted. 2. To evaluate the association of chronic conditions and other factors with unemployment for survivors. We will examine the association of chronic disease status at 2003 with unemployment at 2003 and 2007. Other potential factors, such as sex, diagnosis, and treatment may be examined. Because of differences in employment and chronic conditions by age, we will again examine specific age cohorts. 3. To examine employment transitions of survivors and siblings from 2003 and 2007, and whether chronic disease status in 2003 is associated with these transitions. For example, we will investigate whether survivors who report not working due to health or disability in 2003 continued to be unemployed in 2007, or if they are more likely to transition into other outcomes such as death or being employed by 2007 than siblings.
