Approved Concepts

- Post-traumatic growth and stress, QOL in CCSS (Zebrack)
- Influence of attention on late effects and smoking in teen CCSS (Schum)
- Prevalence of pain in CCSS vs. siblings (Owen)
- Neurosensory complications in CCS (Fowler)
- Stroke in leukemia and CNS survivors (Bowers)

Approved Concepts, cont.

- HRQOL in adult survivors of childhood Wilms' tumor or neuroblastoma (Nathan)
- Suicidal ideation and behavior patterns in CCSS (Recklitis)
- CAM use of CCSS and siblings (Mertens)

Concepts Under Review

- Physical performance and HRQOL in brain tumor survivors (Ness)
- Psychosocial sequelae of infant CCSS (Axia)
- Psychosocial outcomes of bone tumor CCSS (Nagarajan)
- Executive function in survivors vs controls (Ellenberg)
- Neurologic sequelae of ALL survivors (Goldsby)
- Psychological predictors of health behaviors (Park)

Working Concepts

- Attention and executive function in ALL survivors (Kadan-Lottick)
- Dose effect of XRT on daily living skills of medulloblastoma/PNET survivors (King)
- Polymorphisms associated with anxiety and depression in ALL survivors (Kadan-Lottick)

Expanded Cohort Questionnaire

- Delete
 - J1 Cerebral palsy
 - J25, J28 (Not in the BSI-18)
- Edit
 - B17 Add daily non-prescription drugs
 - J38 Consider moving these to other sections of the questionnaire, delete migraine, epilepsy
 - C1-2 Substitute valid hearing questions
 - “Hearing vs. Deafness”

EXPANDED COHORT: Baseline Survey

J13 (change from “prolonged pain or abnormal sensation in arms, legs, or back” to “prolonged pain in arms, legs, or back.”)

J12 add the “abnormal sensation” to J12 (“Decreased sense of touch or feeling or abnormal sensation in hands, fingers, arms, or legs”)

EXPANDED COHORT: Baseline Survey

J7 add “severe” headaches rather than just headaches

After J15, add to neuro section: have you ever had a stroke?

a. did it go away___ or did it last a long time_____

b. did it effect :

speech___

one side of the body___

total body___

EXPANDED COHORT: Baseline Survey

At end of J37, add Q2 E21 (pain) and E22 (pain-related disability)

Put box under Q2E21 rather than under cancer-related attribution of pain (J36)

Eliminate F9 (stroke, since now added to neuro section)
